GRANT OPPORTUNITY - DAIRY BUSINESS BUILDER GRANT

The [Dairy Business Builder Grant](#) is available for small-to-medium size dairy farmers or processors aiming to diversify their on-farm activity. There is \$1,000,000 in grant funding available (up to \$100,000 per project) for proposals that align with at least one of the following goals:

- Dairy farm diversification through dairy product development, specialization, packaging and/or marketing strategies
- Creation of value-added dairy products
- Enhancement of the value of a dairy commodity or by-product through product development or alternate use
- Creation or expansion of a program for exporting dairy products
